

COVID-19 Risk Assessment Statement for Forest of Dean Trust

In response to the global escalation of the coronavirus, the Forest of Dean Trust are taking steps to protect its staff, students and visitors of the schools within it. These measures reflect the advice and guidance of the Government and Public Health England.

Our reassurances to you:

The trust is aware of the UK government guidance surrounding the management of the coronavirus outbreak and are following all necessary guidance on how to protect people from the spread of the disease.
